### Community Outreach

When a parent hears the news that they are miscarrying, they are often given few options to consider; one is to naturally deliver at home. However, parents are sent home and given little education on what to expect next. A miscarriage kit is a great tool to help families gather the remains of their beloved baby. Paired with access to a Perinatal Loss Advocate from Morgan's Place makes the process so much gentler on parents.

On March 11th, the student council members from Troy Christian High School assembled 100 miscarriage kits that Morgan's Place will distribute throughout Ohio and beyond for families in need. Thank you Troy Christian for your part in helping families give their baby a dignified burial.



### Sewing For a Cause

This month Morgan's Place put out a request to have small jar covers made to put in our miscarriage kits that would visually conceal the remains of a baby making the process more dignified for families. In just over 24 hours, 25 women from eight counties responded with their willingness to help. Within 48 hours we had 50 jar covers dropped off at our house. Thank you to all of the those that gave of their time and talent to serve our families and God in this capacity. These will be an ongoing need. # Testimonial in Honor of Luca Schmiesing

On November 1, 2023 we found out we were expecting our third baby. After two healthy pregnancies we had little concerns and at 8 weeks an ultrasound confirmed a healthy heartbeat. We would later receive the news no parent wants to hear. On January 26, 2024 we went in for a 16 week ultrasound only to discover a heartbeat was no longer detected and our baby girl had stopped growing at 13 weeks. 84 days of knowing about you, 84 days of loving you, 84 days of thinking about how perfect our life would be with you in our family.

The hospital gave us multiple options for what we could do next - Alex and I chose to naturally miscarry at home. Knowing it could still be a couple more weeks until the baby would be delivered, they gave us information for Morgan's Place to plan for the weeks ahead. When we got home that afternoon we were numb, shocked and devastated- why us?? I called Mollie later that night, a complete stranger to me she not only gave me her time but also her deepest sympathy. She shared her personal story with me and opened her heart to me, she provided verbal guidance and delivered a miscarriage kit with information for us to navigate the next steps of this awful road.

We peacefully delivered our baby girl, Luca Ann at home the following morning, January 27, 2024 at 9:15 am. The most perfect little babyeyes, nose and perfectly defined fingers and toes. Such a miracle and a true gift from God.

We contacted Morgan's Place that morning and Mollie came to our home and picked up Luca to transfer her to a funeral home until we could schedule a burial. We buried our sweet angel on February 2, 2024. A beautiful burial service was prepared by Mollie & Nathan with Deacon Weubker and our immediate family present. As heartbreaking as this process has been, the support from Morgan's Place has made this so much more peaceful for our family. We are so thankful for Mollie and Nathan for providing Morgan's Place. The most beautiful place to visit our little baby, Luca.
